The Finance Project Director (FPD) position works for the BGD business unit (Business Guidance department), but will be part of the Large Projects Netherlands Area Central team. You will work 1 or 2 days a week at TenneT's head office in beautiful green surroundings in Arnhem. The other days you will work partly from home and partly within the Area where you work.

Large Projects Netherlands is responsible for large onshore (new-build) projects. Our project portfolio will triple in the coming years. To realize our projects on time, within budget, in connection with others and with excellent quality, you and your TenneT colleagues work hard to adapt the current electricity grid so that we are prepared for all the changes. The adaptations are needed in the national 380 kV electricity transmission grid.

Your contribution to TenneT:

Build, build, build, that is the credo more and more. The electricity grid in the Netherlands is being prepared for the future. To this end, the high-voltage grid is being expanded in many places in the Netherlands. This is becoming increasingly visible. In the media, when new projects are announced or construction starts. But we are also increasingly visible outside, where the projects are being built. As Finance Project Director, you are the 'co-pilot' or 'CFO' of the Netherlands' major new construction projects in a geographical area. These are works of between 50 million and 2 billion per project with a total portfolio of multiple billions. They are also long-term works. From start to finish, a project takes between 6 and 15 years. Together with the entire project team, you are responsible for managing these projects in the best possible way.

Your contribution to TenneT

- Together with your Business Counterpart and your team, you are jointly responsible for the results and decisions within your projects;
- You are responsible for the day-to-day management of the project team to meet project requirements and ensure the delivery of project control and administration, risk management, claims and contract management and procurement in your geographical area;
- You are responsible for balanced decision-making together with your business counterpart, considering both project interests and the interests of TenneT as a whole. You ensure that all relevant decisions are made with a true picture of results and risks;
- You are self-reliant in achieving project goals within the limits of the project mandate (budget, time schedule, milestones) and TenneT's processes and guidelines.

- You have at least 10 years of experience in financial controlling and/or finance management and at least 5 years in large construction projects, ideally infrastructure projects
- You have a successfully completed university degree (or comparable) and extensive working experience in financial controlling or finance management, preferably in a project environment.
- You have profound skills in contract- claims- and risk management as well as experience in tender and negotiations
- You have Professional experience and know-how in project
