Your contribution to TenneT 2GW cluster Maasvlakte is looking for a Finance and Purchasing (or Procurement) Coordinator. You will participate in innovative 2GW offshore projects. In this role you will support the project team. As a Finance and Procurement Coordinator you will control and arrange the operational and organizational aspects of the projects, from planning to execution and you will report to the Project Director.

Your main tasks are:
